A Message from your Pastor...

Dear Friends in Christ,

Throughout His ministry Jesus was continually inviting people to come to Him. A few examples:

LUTHERAN CHURCH & SCHOOL

- "Come, follow me," Jesus said, "and I will make you fishers of men." Matt. 4:19
- Then Jesus said, "Let the little children come to me, and do not hinder them, for the kingdom of heaven belongs to such as these." Matt. 19:14
- Then Jesus declared, "I am the bread of life. He who comes to me will never go hungry, and he who believes in me will never be thirsty." John 6:35
- "Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest." Matt. 11:28

Why does Jesus invite us to come to Him? Jesus cares about life. Jesus says in John 11:25-26: "I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in me will live, even though he dies; and whoever lives and believes in me will never die." Jesus brings us life both physically and eternally. He has brought us earthly life by creating and forming us in our mother's womb (see Psalm 139). He has brought us eternal life through his own life, death, and resurrection.

In Jesus, we have life. We know that, but the world does not. The world is familiar with brokenness, hurt, pain, anger, and suffering. We know those things too, but we also know Jesus. In the middle of this month, we enter the season of Lent. It is a season when we focus on the Passion of Jesus. We consider His life, His suffering, and His death. As we reflect again on what Jesus endured for us, we marvel at the fact that because Jesus suffered, we know our suffering will one day come to an end. As we see Jesus endure pain, hurt, and the brokenness of this world, we do so knowing that our pain, our hurt, and our brokenness will one day be gone. Forever. This is the life into which Jesus invites people to come. It is a life of hope. As the Church – the Body of Christ – we have been called to invite people to come to Jesus. To come into the life He has given by His death and resurrection.

And people are ready for Jesus, even if they don't even know it. Consider it this way: Listen to how people talk about how busy, or how difficult, or how challenging their life is. They are talking about their need for Jesus.

The next time you hear a friend, a family member, or a stranger talk about the challenges of life, I pray that you will see the opportunity to invite them to come to Jesus. Invite them to come to church. Invite them to come to your Bible study

group. Invite them to come to our Lenten dinners on Wednesday nights beginning February 14th at 5pm and then to worship at 6:30. Invite them to come to the One who brings life. As Jesus says in John 10:10, "I came that they may have life and have it abundantly."

#### WHATEVER IS LOVELY...

As I was formulating our plan to look at the "whatevers" of Philippians 4:8 throughout the school year, I was pleasantly surprised by how appropriate many of the words seemed to the months that they were assigned...

"Whatever is JUST" in November. "Wow," I thought, "how appropriate that we'll be talking about things that are fair, right, and good in God's eyes as we also get to share His love with people through our Thanksgiving baskets."

And then there was January - "whatever is PURE." Again, how appropriate that we should be thinking about things that are unblemished, fresh, and new at the beginning of a NEW year!

And now we move into February. Perhaps most appropriate of all, we will focus this month on "whatever is LOVELY." Definitions for lovely vary. And when we consider that lovely act, we can be inspired to act with love ourselves.


