"How beautiful are the feet of those who bring good news." (Rom. 10:15 NIV)

Throughout scripture, God has sent many people walking. Consider Abraham, who walked to the land that God would show him. Consider Moses walking on holy ground to the burning bush. And Moses and the Israelites walking in the desert for 40 years. The Old Testament gives one prophet after another—Isaiah, Ezekiel, Jeremiah, Amos, Obadiah, all the way to Malachi—walking among the people to prepare the way for the Savior.

Until it is time for a young unwedded couple to walk down to Bethlehem, carrying the Christ child. Mary and Joseph walked so that Jesus could walk among us. When He took on flesh and blood, Jesus walked right into our sinful condition. He walked among people who were harassed, helpless, as "sheep without a shepherd." And to those people His feet kept walking to bring the healing message of salvation.

Jesus' beautiful feet walked to and through all the circumstances of our life, until the time was right for Him to walk that painful, agonizing walk through the streets of Jerusalem, up Calvary's Hill, ending at the cross. The feet that walked bringing healing and salvation became feet that were nailed to the cross as the final sacrifice for our sins. Jesus walked through the valley of the shadow of death to carry our sins.


But God made feet for walking, and those pierced feet rose on Easter morning and walked out of the tomb. Jesus' feet stood Easter night before the disciples in the upper room, and his feet walked the Emmaus road. Our Lord sent his disciples walking, and He sends us walking—walking with beautiful feet that proclaim the Good News of Jesus.


