A Message from Your Pastor...

Dear Friends in Christ,

Please take a look at this picture below. I took that picture several weeks ago when I went to visit Alberta (on right). I had scheduled to bring her communion when she was living at her daughter's house, but some things changed and she moved into a care center the same day I was scheduled to visit. Much to her surprise (and joy!) she was living in the same building as her dear friend Darlene (on left).

These two ladies know each other because of Trinity. They used to serve together through Trinity's LWML, and their husbands used to serve as ushers. It had been several years since they had seen each other and they were absolutely delighted to catch up with one another. The conversation carried itself as they both shared memories and things going on in their lives and their families. When it came time for a devotion and communion, Darlene said, "This is great! It reminds me of the verse 'Where two or three are gathered in Jesus' name, He is there!"



Indeed, that is exactly what it is like! These two ladies are a part of God's family and connected through Trinity Lutheran Church and School. At the heart of it, we will be having three different call committees working simultaneously. At the end of August, these three committees met for an organizational meeting. They looked at the responsibilities these three positions have individually, but also how they need to complement each other. Next, the committees will meet and consider their specific position responsibilities and next steps. In October or November we plan to have a Congregational Town Hall meeting to share information about the call processes and overall ministry at Trinity. There are a lot of moving parts.

At the same time, we trust what Jesus said in Matthew 18:20: "For where two or three are gathered in my name, there am I among them." Whether we are meeting as a whole congregation in worship or as a smaller group on boards and committees, we do not meet alone. Jesus is present. It is His Church, and we follow Him. Together. Supporting, encouraging, and walking together as friends in Christ.
