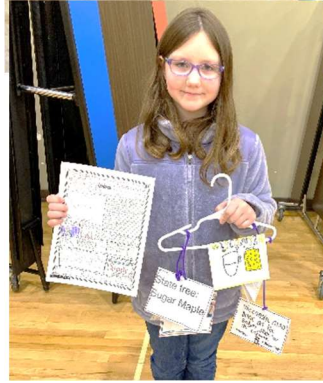
State Parade
