SUMMER DAYCARE!

Our Daycare is open all summer. Hours are from 7:30 A.M. till 5:30 P.M. Monday through Friday. Children must be 3 and toilet trained to attend. The cost is \$450 per month for June through August, for full time and \$25 per day for part time. The hourly rate is \$4 per hour. We do allow part time but you must call the Daycare at least the day before to be sure we have sufficient staff scheduled for the numbers of children attending. We also are requiring that fees are paid in advance. If you have any questions please call Jodi Kesler at 651-1016.

BE SURE FEES ARE PAID!

All fees must be paid by the last day of school, Friday, May 26. This includes Tuition, daycare, band fees, lunches, lost or damaged books or padlocks. School policy mandates that Report Cards will be held until these fees are taken care of. For students that will not be returning to Trinity next year, we will not forward records to their new school until all financial obligations have been resolved. This does include 8th Graders going on to High School. If

you have questions or concerns, please contact Mrs. Heiliger in the office. There will be a note listing fees due going home next week.

IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENT FOR NEXT YEARS 7TH GRADERS.

Montana Immunization Law requires that we have documentation of required immunizations before the first day of school. Students entering 7th Grade are required to have a Td booster (tetanus and diphtheria). Summer is a great time to get this done and then make sure that we have a copy in the office.
