
Greetings. It sure was fun Saturday night at church. I also enjoy listening to Praise Band. They really enhance worship. I was delighted to see a

We are encouraging families to register for next year through the Sycamore admissions portal. Enrolling through Sycamore will allow families to update family information and complete much of the required "paperwork" that was previously completed at the beginning of each school year.

If you do not know your user name and/or password please contact the office and we will reset it for you. This process takes about 20 minutes and is easiest if you use a computer. We have a computer available in the office if you would like to use it. The admissions portal is not available in the phone app. Read through the "pre-enrollment message" after logging in for important instructions that will help with the process. After you have submitted your enrollment you will need to bring a check for your enrollment fee to the office. If you have not previously turned in your child's birth certificate and immunizations, or if your child's immunizations have been updated, please bring a copy to the office when you pay registration.
