FLOW! A financial summary of our 2022-2023 fiscal year is available in paper form in the narthex. This report was prepared by our Treasurer, David Ottolino, and is yet another example of how God continues to pour out His blessings upon us. We ended the fiscal year with an operating surplus in our general fund of a little over \$100K. About half of this surplus remains in the general fund to provide cash flow flexibility as we move forward, while the other half was transferred to a savings fund for the Council to utilize for unanticipated projects and ministry advancement. We encourage you to review this information and offer a prayer of thanksgiving for how God continues to provide for the ministry and mission at Trinity!
