BRING YOUR MITES NEXT WEEKEND!

This past month in Sunday School, the children have been learning about stewardship, and how God calls all of us to enjoy His gifts, take care of them, and share them with others. The children have been collecting mites (aka coins: see Mark 12:41-44) to donate to the Lutheran Women's Missionary League's (LWML) Mite Box program. These mites support missions around the world, including the Muddy Cluster and Manitoba Missions that Trinity is involved in. The first weekend of every month is *Mite Box Weekend*, when these coins are collected at Trinity. The kids have been filling their Mite Boxes, and next weekend they are asking YOU to be a part of the mite box drive, too! Please plan to bring some coins for Mite Box Weekend on May 1 & 2. The kids will be collecting mites in the church entry after each worship service. If you would like to make this a regular practice in your household, please pick up a Mite Box in the church entry so you have a place to collect your coins throughout the month. A few coins may not seem like much, but each year the LWML is collectively able to donate nearly \$1 Million dollars to mission programs because of these coins. God can take the little that we give and turn it into a lot!
