### **Voters' Meeting & Synod Results**

The LCMS has asked all congregations in the synod to vote as to whether or not the synodical convention, which takes place every 3 years, should be moved back a year due to the impact of the pandemic. Trinity voted in favor of delaying the convention, and this week the LCMS shared: “More than the required one-fourth (63.32%) of the Synod’s member congregations registered a vote, and the majority (90.67%) of votes cast favored adoption ... The member congregations of the Synod and all who facilitated their voting are to be thanked for their urgent and diligent attention to this question, on account of which it was able to be decided not only by a majority of the votes cast but by a majority of the member congregations. We pray that the additional year it allows will bear rich fruit in the churchly deliberative assemblies of the districts and the Synod.”
