Stewardship Corner

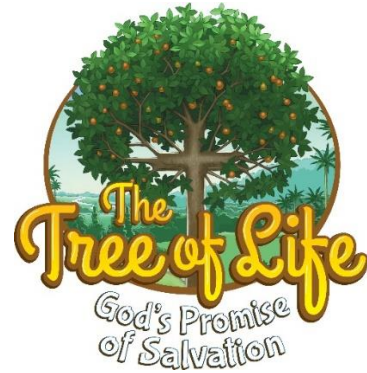
Luke 10:20b – “*But rejoice that your names are written in heaven.*”
