Cross Display

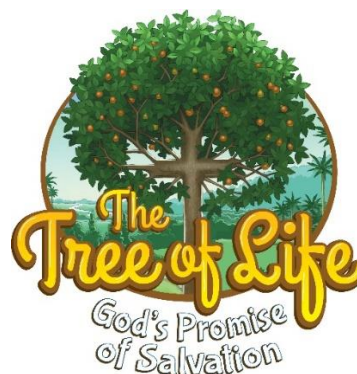
