A Message from Your Pastor...

Dear Friends in Christ,

"The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few. Therefore pray earnestly to the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into his harvest." Luke 10:2

You may recall that we celebrated National Lutheran Schools Week from February 26-March 3. The week contained various activities at the school, including a visit from our Montana District President, Pastor Terry Forke. Not only did President Forke lead chapel on Wednesday, he also visited every classroom. In each classroom he led a devotion, prayed, and spoke about the importance of church workers.

Specifically, Pastor Forke spoke about a Synod initiative called "Set Apart to Serve." According to our Synod's website (lcms.org), the purpose of this initiative is "to encourage the young people in our Synod to treasure the gifts God has given them for service, and to consider the opportunities available to serve Him full time in His church." There are many ways for people to serve in God's church full time. Think of pastors, Lutheran school teachers, directors of Christian education, directors of Christian outreach, directors of family life ministries, directors of music, and deaconesses. We have several of those opportunities at Trinity, and we are thankful for people willing to serve in these various roles.

At the same time, thinking about the need for more church workers in God's harvest field strikes us differently in this month of June. During National Lutheran Schools Week we knew of Trinity's need for a pastor following Pastor Rinderknecht's retirement. But now, we think of our principal, Mr. Rick Thomas, who at our May voters' meeting announced his retirement at the end of the next school year (2023-2024). He will have served faithfully for 42 years, and Trinity has been blessed by his service.

We also think of our music director, Mr. Nick Harding, who has received a call to serve as the music director at Trinity Lutheran Church and School in Crown Point, Indiana. At the time of my writing this article, his deliberation continues. If he remains at Trinity, we will be blessed by his service; and if not, we trust in the Lord who provides for His church.

That's what Jesus teaches us to do in the verse above from Luke 10. As Jesus is sending out 72 disciples into the harvest field, he calls them to "therefore pray earnestly to the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into his harvest." There is much ministry to be done and a need for more workers. I would encourage you to pray for more people to enter full-time ministry. Ask the Lord of the harvest to send more workers into the harvest field, not just for Trinity, but for God's kingdom.

One of the ways God has already answered this prayer is by sending one of our members to seminary. Along with his wife, Abby, Noah Oloff will be attending Concordia Seminary in St. Louis, Missouri. This decision has not come lightly for Noah and Abby, as they have been prayerfully considering this for quite some time. Noah's classes will begin in June as he learns the biblical language of Greek. Abby will continue working in Billings until the fall. They need our prayers. They need our support and encouragement. We will have a little sending for the Oloffs on June 11 (see more on the insert).

The Oloffs work and ministry in the Lord's harvest field may not lead them to serve at Trinity in Billings, Montana. And that's okay. We will support and encourage them, knowing that they will be serving Jesus. Jesus is the Lord of the harvest. It is His kingdom. It is His Church. And we will continue to prayand trust—that the Lord will "send out laborers into his harvest."


