A Message from Your Pastor...

Dear Family of God at Trinity,

Wow! Your support and encouragement of Pastor and Cathy Rinderknecht at Pastor's retirement celebration on February 19th was awesome! The food was delicious. The program was personal. The gym was full of people talking with one another. It was a great celebration! A few thank you's are in order...

Thank you to Vicki Carstens and the retirement celebration committee for organizing everything and taking care of the details. Thank you to Pam Kercher and the Fellowship team for serving the meal and helping in different ways. Thank you to Stacie Shaw for the amazing decorations. Thank you to all of the people who worked behind the scenes to make the celebration run smoothly and be enjoyable—like Janese Carstens recording and putting together some of the videos. You all did well! And thank you to you, the family of God at Trinity Lutheran Church and School, for the outpouring of love and encouragement you showed to Pastor Rinderknecht. God certainly used Pastor to touch many lives throughout his 20 years of service at Trinity. The celebration on the 19th honored Pastor's service and God's faithfulness in caring for His people and His church through the pastoral office.

While we celebrate with Pastor Rinderknecht at his retirement, we also realize that his leaving creates a pastoral vacancy at Trinity. So what happens next? That's an appropriate question many people have been asking at Trinity recently, and I'd like to briefly respond.

First, let's remember that our God is faithful. This isn't the first time Trinity has been faced with a pastoral vacancy—even for a senior pastor. Throughout our history as a congregation, various pastors have come and gone, and yet each time there was a vacancy, God was faithful in providing the right servant at the right time. God gives us this promise in Jeremiah 3:15, where He says, "I will give you shepherds after my own heart, who will feed you with knowledge and understanding." God has been faithful in providing servants for His people, and we trust His Word that He will continue to do so for us.

Second, as a congregation of the Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod, we have agreed to follow a formal process in calling a pastor. It is a process that tends to the task of filling a pastoral vacancy, but it does so in a way that helps the congregation trust in the Lord to provide the proper man for the call. Some of the parts of the process include prayer, establishing a call committee, completing a congregational self-study, prayer, collecting names of potential candidates in conjunction with the District Office, interviewing candidates, prayer, having a call meeting to extend a call, prayer. Did I mention prayer? At the heart of this process, we trust God is at work to lead and direct us to the man He would have Trinity call as pastor. It is also because of this process that the associate pastor does not automatically become the senior pastor. We follow the call process we have agreed to follow as a congregation of the LCMS.

In the meantime, I invite you and encourage you to bring this process before the Lord in prayer. Thank God for His faithfulness in always providing pastors for Trinity—for Pastor Rinderknecht's service, as well as for Pastor Zagel's willingness to serve as pastoral assistant during the interim.

Ask God to lead and direct the call process. Ask Him to guide us as a congregation, that we may always trust in His faithfulness—especially to provide the right man to serve as senior pastor at Trinity.
