A Message from Your Pastor...

Dear Family of God at Trinity,

"Knowing Christ and Making Him Known" summarizes the mission of Trinity Lutheran Church and School. On Easter Sunday, April 9th, we will fulfill this mission as we will celebrate Jesus' resurrection from the dead. It is a day full of hope, joy, and excitement as we rejoice in the life that Jesus has won for us. On the 9th, we will have an outdoor sunrise service at 6:30am (look for details inside this newsletter) in addition to our regular worship times of 8am and 10:30am at the church. During these worship services (and every worship service) we get to "know Christ" and all that He has done for us. But "Knowing Christ" is only half the mission: We don't keep what we know to ourselves; we make it known to others.

Consider the first women to the tomb on that first Easter. In Matthew 28, after the angel told them that Jesus was not in the tomb but had risen, he showed them the place where he lay. Then he said, "*Go quickly and tell his disciples that he has risen from the dead*" (v. 7). After learning what happened to Jesus, the women did what the angel instructed – they went and "made known" that Jesus was alive. In worship on Easter Sunday, we will hear (again) about Jesus' resurrection, and we will make it known by broadcasting the service through various avenues.

Although worship services do fulfill this mission, it would also be accurate to say that "Knowing Christ" happens through worship, and "Making Him Known" often happens outside of worship. Consider for example, some of the ways the Holy Spirit has used us to help "make Christ known" in the last month or so:

- Adult Instruction/New Member Class began
- *Money 101* classes that Trinity members help teach to people in Love INC's Transformational Ministry program

- The completion of Trinity's first year of financial support for St. John Lutheran Church & School in Uganda, totaling more than \$6000 (1/3 of their annual operational budget!)
- Weekly Bible Studies
- Helping people physically with food and/or spiritually with scripture and prayer
- Serving grieving families with a meal after a funeral
- Special school activities during National Lutheran Schools Week
- LaVie Early Pregnancy Services coin drive totaling \$1,204
- President Forke speaking in each classroom about God's enduring Word, and also encouraging students to go into church work
- Organ tuning (it's been more than 2 years... long story)
- Providing space for "Young Lives" to lead a weekly Bible Study for young/teen moms
- Serving high schoolers lunch on Mondays
- Sharing Jesus and teaching the faith with 300+ students and their families through the school
- And more...

I share this list of ministries at Trinity not to "pat ourselves on the back" – but to encourage you in sharing the hope we have in Jesus. It is a hope rooted in the death and resurrection of Jesus! Please join in the Easter celebration in worship – and then join us in "Making Christ Known" to people who need Jesus.
