

A Message from Your Pastor...

Dear Friends of Trinity,

In May of 2015, the people of Trinity moved forward in faith as they broke ground for Phase 1 of our Facility Expansion Project. Expanding the parking lot at church and adding classrooms, daycare, a library, and computer lab at the school encompassed this phase of growth. Now, four years and three months after the start of that project, God's Word reminds us of why Trinity is here, and why that expansion was necessary. We read just a few weeks ago in worship, "*The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few. Therefore pray earnestly to the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest.*" Luke 10:2

The harvest certainly is plentiful in Billings Montana. Just consider what's happening this year at the school. Right now (in mid-July when I'm writing this) our enrollment for grades K-8 at the school stands at 172 students. Although this number will fluctuate before the start of school, it's a solid number of students.

Even more, the need for early childhood care has continued to increase. Since the new addition, our Preschool program went from about 20 students at the house across the street, to 60 students last school year. This year, we have 62 students currently enrolled, with new families inquiring weekly about our programs. Feedback and interest from families have moved us to add more Early Childhood Classes. Specifically, for the first time, we are now offering two Pre-K classes, one in the morning and one in the afternoon that meet 5 days a week. This is in addition to our 2-day and 3-day Preschool classes, and our Kindergarten class, all of which are half-day programs. This growth, not only in enrollment, but also in responsibilities and care for families, has moved the school to need an Early Childhood Director. Mrs. Sara Reintsma, who has been serving Trinity Lutheran School as a Preschool and Resource Teacher for the last six years, will be fulfilling the responsibilities of this new position. In her position as the Early Childhood Director, Mrs. Reinstma will oversee the Daycare, and all Preschool and Pre-K classes. I am thankful the Lord has provided Sara to serve in this capacity, and I invite you to encourage and support her in her new role.

This all points to the truth of Jesus' words indeed, "the harvest is plentiful." One hundred years ago people moved forward in faith and started a congregation known as Trinity Lutheran Church because they trusted Jesus' words. I doubt any of them who started this mission knew what the church and school would look like today. But today, not much has changed from 100 years ago. God's people continue to trust God's Word and move forward in faith, faith not in what we do, but

in what God has done for us through His Son Jesus. As the Psalmist writes, "*The Lord has done great things for us, and we are filled with joy.*" *Psalm* 126:3
