Al Message from Your Pastor...

I invite you to try something right now. On the back of this newsletter or on a scrap piece of paper, write your first name 5 times. Ready? Go! Now, do that again-but this time, write your name five times with your other hand. Are you ready? Give it a try!

How did that go? Obviously, it is easier and your name is probably more legible on the first list as compared to the second list. I remember doing that exercise as a group activity many years ago, and when I did that again today, not much has changed – my left-handed writing still isn't very good. When I participated in that exercise a while back, our group facilitator pointed out that it is easier, more efficient, and actually very enjoyable to use our strengths when we are given a task to complete. The point being that we need to focus on our strengths more than our weaknesses.

Yet it seems commonplace for us, and sometimes others, to notice our weaknesses rather than our strengths. That's part of our sinful nature. We readily see what we are not able to do, or we easily remember our failures, or we compare ourselves with others and find we don't live up to the expectations. But when is the last time you considered the things that you do well? If someone were to ask you, "What are your strengths," how would you answer?

God has given you gifts and abilities to use in various areas of life. That's the promise of Romans 12:4-6: "For as in one body we have many members, and the members do not all have the same function, so we, though many, are one body in Christ, and individually members one of another. Having gifts that differ according to the grace given to us." The talents and abilities that you have are gifts from God: gifts that God desires you to use for His glory. Using your gifts for God's glory means that you use them in service to Him and others. It also means that when you must do or accomplish something that you don't have the ability to do, asking others to help is a good thing. That's what Paul is talking about in verse 4 of Romans 12—that we are "one body" with "many members." God has given each of us different gifts and abilities to support and help each other, and together we make up the body of Christ with all of its members.

In the early part of September, we will be celebrating Rally Day at the school. I know this is only August and Rally Day is more than a month away, but I would invite you to plan to attend now. It will be Sunday, September 11, at 10am. But don't "just attend." Come prepared to sign up and use your gifts. Why? Because during Rally Day we will have a ministry fair that highlights many of the different ways Trinity Lutheran Church and School shares God's Word and serves people in our community of Billings and beyond. It will be a time to not only learn about the opportunities Trinity has for ministry, but also a time for you to sign up to utilize your gifts for ministry.

There are so many ways to serve the Lord at and through Trinity. You'll have to come to the ministry fair to see all the different opportunities. Until then, be thinking about your strengths. Be thinking about what you do well and how your strength could be used to help proclaim God's Word and serve His people. Be also in prayer. Pray for God's continued blessing on the work and ministry of Trinity Lutheran Church and School. And be praying about how God could use you and your gifts to serve in His Kingdom.


