A Message from Your Pastor...

Dear Friends of Trinity,

As we move into the month of December, we move into the month of "surprises"! Our family enjoys surprises. Especially surprise visits! Since our children and grandchildren all live in Canada, visits are precious and important. A number of years ago, before she was married, our third daughter, Ditza, was planning a surprise visit on Christmas Eve. She was going to fly out on the morning of December 24th from Vancouver Island and get to Billings mid-afternoon. The plan was that she would come to the Christmas Eve Candlelight Service and sit down next to her unsuspecting mother! That surprise didn't work. Ditza phoned me about 10:00 am on Christmas Eve and, with tears, gave me the surprise that she missed her flight! She slept in too long! (That has been Ditza all throughout her life. We had to drag her out of bed for school every morning!) Fortunately, she could get a flight out on Christmas morning and make it that evening as a special surprise package on Christmas Day.


