# A Message from Your Pastor...

Dear Friends of Trinity,

In James 4:13-15 we read, "Come now, you who say, 'Today or tomorrow we will go into such and such a town and spend a year there and trade and make a profit'— yet you do not know what tomorrow will bring. What is your life? For you are a mist that appears for a little time and then vanishes. Instead you ought to say, 'If the Lord wills, we will live and do this or that." God would have these words bring us back to humble faith and a realization that in every moment of our lives we are completely dependent upon Him.

We have our plans, we have our ideas and goals that we eagerly pursue. We move forward "full steam ahead"... and we forget how dependent we are on the Lord's will and blessing until something suddenly comes along and changes everything. That is what the Covid-19 Pandemic has done. It changes our plans and goals: we can't visit loved ones, vacations are cancelled, businesses are closed, church services are suspended, and so on!

I don't know anyone personally who is sick or has died from the Coronavirus. We are blessed to be in Montana where the numbers are comparatively low. But still we are affected in some way and the Lord would use this time and His Word to bring us back to humble faith in Him. But I do know a family who has experienced the sudden, life changing event of an accident that God has been using to bring them and many others to a deeper, humble faith.

With permission from our Executive Director, Mike Larson, I share the story of his wife, Tami. Mike and Tami are avid cyclists. Just a few weeks ago on a vigorous ride, the front wheel of Tami's bike suddenly locked up causing her to fly over the handle bars and suffer life-threatening injuries. Bones were broken, including her neck. There was a spinal cord injury which caused her to lose the ability to breathe. It happened right in front of the VA hospital at shift change so within seconds there was a gathering of medical professionals to assist which certainly saved her life. Tami's life was in the balance and her future was in grave doubt.

Miracle after miracle has followed this tragic accident as witnessed by Mike. "It happened at a place and time that Tami received immediate medical attention. While the first impressions were that Tami would be completely paralyzed and bound to a respirator for the rest of her life, now in a Denver hospital, she is talking, moving her feet and hands more and more, and will probably be off the respirator by Memorial Day." This sudden change in the Larson family has blessed them with humble faith in the Lord who has used this to draw them closer to Him and to realize anew that they can always depend on Him. Another significant blessing is that this sudden change has given them a renewed perspective on what truly matters in life - our relationship with God who gives life and the blessings of family and loving ones.

May the Lord continue to draw them and us closer to Him and the great gift of Jesus, our Savior and Lord.


