A Message from Your Pastor...

Dear Friends of Trinity,

By the time you read this, I expect that the weather forecast is looking a little brighter. Right now it is still very WINTERY!! They say this is Montana's hardest winter in 40 years, especially as far as the snow in concerned. Most of the people that I talk to are getting weary of the weather and are tired of snow removal and the difficulty of travel. We have hit some very low temperatures as well, starting at Christmas time, and it seems that we have been cold ever since. We certainly are looking forward to spring and more favorable forecasts! But what about the forecast for Trinity Lutheran Church and School?

I bring this point to have you think and pray about some changes that we are going to face soon. I am not talking about the weather now, but about something that we have been announcing for a few months already. On May 1, Connie Klundt will be retiring from her position as Church Secretary and in August Beth Heiliger will also be retiring from being School Secretary. We want to do everything we can to affirm and encourage our new workers so that their labor with us will be joyful and blessed for many years to come!

What about the forecast for Trinity? The weather service bases its forecasts on many factors that are tested by scientific instruments. Their predictions are more or less accurate. As we look to the future changes that I am highlighting here, we don't rely on human data and

science, but on the promises and "track record" of the Lord. We look to His Word and have confidence that He will work all things out for our good and to His glory. I leave you with His Word to us in Jeremiah 29:11 to ponder and receive with thanks: "For I know the plans I have for you," declares the LORD, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future."

THE TRINITY FAMILY




