This October 31st marks the 500th anniversary of the Reformation! What does this mean?

- We are privileged to be living in this time in history.
- God has blessed the Reformation movement with meaning even after 500 years.
- We should reflect on the blessings of our Reformation heritage.
- We can take this opportunity to learn more about the Reformation.
- It is a good opportunity to consider the importance of reformation in our lives.

This study will continue into the Christmas season. We have already discussed the main teaching of God's Word that has been emphasized since the Reformation: "(Salvation) Justification by Grace through Faith in Jesus Christ alone."

The celebration of the one-half millennium of the Reformation can help us to think about the importance of reformation in our lives. Reformation was about returning to the clear teachings of

God's Word. We would do well as members of Trinity to take this seriously and continue to return over and over again to the clear and powerful teachings of God's Word for our own welfare and for our witness to others.
