# A Message from Your Pastor...

Dear Friends in Christ,

I recently finished *Not A Fan* by Kyle Idleman. (This book was recommended to me by Cameron Heiliger about a year ago. He used it with part of the Youth Group at church.) In the book, Kyle Idleman talks about the differences between people who are "fans" of Jesus, and people who "follow Jesus." He talks about fans who want to be a part of something, but are not committed. He talks about followers who are completely focused on and immersed in what they are following. Kyle makes some good points in the book, and he also says some things that we would say or understand differently within the LCMS. But overall, I think he raises a question for people to consider, "What's my relationship with Jesus like?"

How would you answer that question? Maybe your relationship with Jesus is strong. That's great. I'd invite you to join us in worship, in Bible Study, in small groups - to keep you grounded in the faith and strong in the Lord. Or maybe your relationship with Jesus needs to be strengthened. That's why Trinity is here. We are here for people to grow in their relationship with Jesus. Our brief mission statement says it this way, "Knowing Christ and Making Him Known."


So let's go! Let's follow Jesus together. Let's grow in our relationship
